

# Bullock Bags Two Golden Globe Noms - 67th Annual Golden Globes? on omg! on Yahoo!

Touchstone/Warner Brothers After years of endearing audiences as one of America's most recognizable and hard-working actresses, Sandra Bullock is finding new -- and serious -- recognition coming her way. The Hollywood Foreign Press has graced her with two Golden Globe nominations for a pair of her 2009 movies: one for "The Blind Side" (Drama), and another for "The Proposal" (Musical or Comedy). So could getting nominated in not just one, but *two* different categories mean that Bullock could potentially win two Globes in January? Given the strength of her work, it's very possible.

These noms mark Bullock's first Golden Globe nomination since 2001's "Miss Congeniality," and her first-ever double Globe nod (landing her in the unique and impressive company of another 40-plus female lead, Meryl Streep, this year). But 2009 has been much more than congenial for Sandra Bullock. It's been outright outstanding. With over \$300 million domestic gross tallied for "Blindside" and "Proposal," yearlong positive press, and the heart of awards season ahead of her, Bullock's career is shining brightly right now. (Plus, we've all but forgotten about her other 2009 flick, "All About Steve." Never heard of it? Exactly.)

It also bears noting that Bullock has never been nominated for an Academy Award. Now with potentially two Globes in her immediate future, might more golden statuettes start to call her name? Stay tuned.
